#### HIGH POINT ROCKERS NEWS AND NOTES

What's the Point?: The Rockers wrap up their series against Southern Maryland today before meeting with Gastonia again next week, as the South Division race heads toward the end of the first half. High Point remains four games back of Gastonia entering the day, after both teams won on Saturday night. That deficit is tied for their largest in the division at any point this season. With six of the final 11 games in the first half coming against their in-state foes, the opportunity still remains for the Rockers to capture back-to-back first half championships. However, there's little room for error moving forward as the situation nears "must win" territory.

About Last Night: The Rockers secured another victory last night by a final of 9-1, using an eleven batter second inning to plate six runs to thrust them to the win. Jake Washer got the scoring started with a laser to the left-center gap that plated a pair to make it 2-0. The very next batter, Clayton Mehlbauer, sent a weak ground ball to the right side of the infield that allowed Zander Wiel to score and inch it to 3-0. Following that, DJ Burt who punched a single to left that brought home another tally to make it a 4-0 score. To cap off the inning, a wild pitch chased in Burt to give High Point a 5-0 lead, and then Ben Aklinski knocked in the sixth run on an RBI base hit. High Point added on in the fifth when Colin Moran swatted his seventh homer of the year to lead off the inning and lift the score to 7-0. One inning later, it was again Moran who came up and sliced a double to the opposite field gap and drove in two more, pushing the score to 9-0. With the Rockers running away with it, Southern Maryland scratched across one run in the top of the eighth, but it was nowhere near enough as the Rockers coasted to the finish line.

Strikeout Surge: Southern Maryland is a free swinging team, and the Rockers have exploited that. Through eight match-ups this season, High Point pitching has fanned 107 Blue Crabs hitters, an average of 13.4 per contest. For the season, Rocker arms have whiffed a league high 537 batters, while Southern Maryland has struck out 533 times, a league-high, after another 13 K's last night. The Rockers' staff has logged 13 or more K's in seven of eight games vs. SMD this season.

Hangin' Around: High Point secured a series victory with their win last night, defeating Southern Maryland by a final of 9-1. Now, with only 11 games remaining in the half, the Rockers are still staring up at their largest deficit in the division all year, as Gastonia is riding a seven-game winning streak. Ironically, the last time High Point trailed by four games was also the last time Southern Maryland was in town on May 10. Six of the remaining 11 games will come against Gastonia, so while the door is still open for the Rockers, the margin for error is slim. GBC continues its series at Charleston today, as their magic number to clinch the first half

Marvelous Moran: Colin Moran enjoyed his best offensive day as a Rocker last night, going 4-for-5 with a homer and 3 RBI while scoring a pair of runs. He boosted his average to .286 on the season, after having just two hits over his previous five games. Moran broke out of his mini-slump in a big way, posting his ninth multi-hit game of the year.

Here Comes The Sun: The Rockers have thrived in day games so far this year, with a dazzling 12-1 record. They've also crushed competition prior to the sun going down, outscoring opponents 65-21. High Point has held opposition to a pair of runs or fewer in all but two of their twelve day match-ups. Their next chance at a day time victory comes today in the finale versus Southern Maryland

Second Is The Best: High Point struck for six runs in the second inning alone last night, catapulting them to victory on Saturday night. High Point sent 11 batters to the plate in the inning. On the season, the second inning has been the Rockers most productive, scoring more runs in that inning alone than any other, while outscoring opponents 43-15 in that one frame.

Keep An Eye On Aklinski: Ben Aklinski remains just a hit shy of 300 in his Rockers career, after collecting one in the ballgame last night. He would become just the second Rocker to reach that plateau, joining former teammate Michael Russell who tallied 363 hits over his High Point tenure from 2019-23.
