#### THE MAIN POINT

The Rockers have just three games remaining in the regular season before opening the playoffs at Gastonia on Saturday night. The Ghost Peppers clinched a playoff berth last Friday, securing the second half South Division title and setting up an DCS matchup with High Point for the third time in four years. High Point aims to swing momentum back to its side over the next three nights against Charleston, looking to take advantage of a team that has dropped its last 11 games. Fin Del Bonta-Smith makes an abbreviated start tonight with Erich Uelmen also making an appearance as High Point preps its first two starters for the playoff series.

#### SCOUTING THE COMPETITION

#### ABOUT THE DIRTY BIRDS

High Point concludes the regular season this week against the Dirty Birds who are on one of the longest losing streaks in the ALPB this season. Charleston comes into tonight having dropped 11 in a row. The Birds have also gone through a roster overhaul, releasing three of their top performers in Joseph Rosa, David Lebron and Eddy Demurias on 9/9.

#### WHO'S ON DECK?

High Point turns its attention to the playoffs, beginning this Saturday night at CaroMont Health Park against the Gastonia Ghost Peppers. High Point went 17-10 against their division rival during the regular season, and will now face them for the third time in four years in the postseason. Last time they matched up in the ALDS in 2023, Gastonia won the series in five games.

#### SERIES RECORD

High Point leads the season set 12-9 despite alternating wins and losses with the Birds over the last five games. High Point with just a single win this week will secure a season series victory.

# HIGH POINT ROCKERS NEWS AND NOTES

## We Are The Champions, My Friend

High Point punched its ticket to the postseason, clinching the South Division first half championship June 28 with a 5-3 victory over Lancaster. The Rockers tied the club record for wins in a half-season with 41 also achieved by both the 2019 and 2023 teams.

## We Meet Again

High Point has held a playoff spot since June 28 after clinching the first half, and with just three games left in the regular season, they now know their first round opponent. A Gastonia win and Lexington loss on Saturday night has set up a playoff match-up between the Rockers and Ghost Peppers for the third time in four years. High Point has not seen the Ghost Peppers since July 27 and are 17-10 against their division rival in 2025.

## Playoffs? Playoffs?

High Point returns to the playoffs for the first time since 2023 when they lost to Gastonia in five games in the DCS after defeating them the season prior. Both times the two in-state rivals have met in the postseason, the series has gone to five games. High Point is 5-11 all-time in the playoffs, reaching the championship series in 2022.

## Record Watch

High Point has a pathway to reaching one of its best records in franchise history over their last three games if they can sweep Charleston. High Point's most wins in a season came in 2023 (78) and was followed by winning 74 last year. They enter tonight with 72.

## Where Have The Bats Gone?

At one time, the High Point offense was at the top of the league, but has stalled lately, scoring four runs or less in seven of their last 20 games. Saturday and Sunday in Southern Maryland, they combined for just two runs on ten hits.

## Aklinski Is An Anomaly

Ben Aklinski has a laundry list of accolades and accomplishments in his illustrious ALPB career, and he's coming up on another milestone. With 94 RBI, he's 6 shy of his third 100-RBI campaign, which would make him the only player in league history with three such seasons. In one swing on 9/10, he clubbed his 32nd homer of the season, matching a club record, and notched the 12th grand slam of his HP career.

## Comeback Kings

High Point has played 30 games this season in which they have trailed at some point and come back to win.

## Blown Away By The Bullpen

With the offense having been quiet recently, the bullpen has picked up the slack. Over the last three games, the relievers have gone 8.1 scoreless innings, keeping the Rockers in the game.

## Naple(ton) Is An Offensive Staple

Rockers catcher Luke Napleton has recorded hits in 23 of 29 games he's suited up in, and despite not having one Saturday night, he brought home the go-ahead run with a clutch sac-fly in the 8th inning.

## Luis Is Hotter Than Fish Grease

Luis Gonzalez has been one of the hottest hitters in the league for the better part of a month now, riding a 29-game on-base streak, the second longest by a Rocker this year to Aklinski's 37-game streak. In total, the former big leaguer is hitting .296 with 20 homers and 70 RBI. He had a 13-game hitting streak come to an end on Saturday, but has recorded hits in 14 of the last 15 he's played.

## NUMBERS TO KNOW

**6:** High Point is playing its sixth season in franchise history in 2025

**100:** Ben Aklinski became the third player in league history with 100 homers and 100 stolen bases on 6/5. He currently has 129 homers and 114 stolen bases for his ALPB career

**20:** Ben Aklinski with his stolen base (7/26) became the first player in ALPB history with three consecutive 20 HR/20 SB seasons.

**433:** High Point has the most wins of any club in the Atlantic League over the last five seasons and now into the 2025 season

**502:** The Rockers have owned a record of .500 or better in 502 straight games dating back to April 22, 2022 when they were 1-2 after losing two of the first three at Kentucky


