THE MAIN POINT

The Rockers look to stave off elimination and keep their season alive, now trailing York 2-1 in the LCS after a 5-2 loss last night. Solo homers in the seventh from Alex Dickerson and DJ Burt cut the deficit to 4-2, but that was as close as the Rockers got. For the second time this post-season, the Rockers will play with their season on the line after winning Game 5 in the SDCS against Gastonia. York is one win away from a fifth championship in franchise history, which would put them second behind Somerset's six, and they'd become the first team in ALPB history with two sets of back-to-back titles. Fin Del Bonta-Smith gets the start for High Point for a second time in a must-win game this postseason, tossing five innings and allowing one run in Game 5 of the SDCS against the Ghost Peppers.

SCOUTING THE COMPETITION

ABOUT THE REVOLUTION

York enters the Championship Series after a 74-win regular season, tied with High Point for the best overall mark in the league. The Revs, who won the league title last season, are looking to repeat for a second time in franchise history after having done so in 2010 and 2011. It would be York's fifth championship, the most among active teams in the ALPB and the second-most all-time behind Somerset's six. York defeated Lancaster in three games in the NDCS to reach the ALCS, outscoring the Stormers 16-8.

CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES HISTORY

High Point and York meet for the first time in the ALCS, with High Point 0-1 and York 4-0 all-time upon reaching the final round. High Point was defeated 3-0 in 2022 by Lancaster, and York most recently took down the Charleston Dirty Birds last season 3-0 to sweep its way to a title. York is now 14-2 all-time in LCS games after taking a 2-1 lead in this LCS with a win last night.

SERIES RECORD

The Rockers and Revs split the season set 3-3, with each visiting team winning two games in each three game set. High Point outscored the Revs 55-43 in the six meetings, including a 22-12 win on 7/16. All-time High Point owns a 35-31 advantage over the Revs while the two teams are a dead-even 15-15 in games played at WellSpan Park.

HIGH POINT ROCKERS NEWS AND NOTES

We Are The Champions, My Friend

High Point punched its ticket to the postseason, clinching the South Division first half championship June 28 with a 5-3 victory over Lancaster. The Rockers tied the club record for wins in a half-season with 41 also achieved by both the 2019 and 2023 teams.

Championship Or Bust

High Point returns to the Championship Series for the first time since 2022 and just the second time in franchise history. They meet the York Revolution, who tied High Point for the most wins in the regular season with 74. York is 4-0 all-time in the LCS, and 14-2 in LCS games. The Rockers earned their first LCS win on Sunday, 9-3. High Point is 4-4 in these playoffs, while York is 5-1.

A Rockers Revolution

The Rockers meet the Revs for a third series this season, this time with the ALPB Championship on the line. The regular season series was split 3-3, with the road team winning two of three in each previous set. In all three games the Rockers won, they scored in double-digits, including a season-high 22 runs in a 22-12 win at York on 7/17.

Gonzalez For MVP

Luis Gonzalez was named SDCS MVP and very deservedly so, after hitting .381 (8-for-21) with a pair of homers, two RBI's and a couple of walks along with seven runs scored. In addition to Gonzalez's exceptional performance, Evan Edwards (.286, 2 HR, 8 RBI) and Drew Mendoza (.409) also put up performances worthy of MVP consideration.

To The Left, To The Left

High Point's left-handed hitters have mashed in the postseason thus far, with all five LHH combining to hit .331 (46-for-139). Evan Edwards, Luis Gonzalez and Drew Mendoza each have recorded 11 hits in eight games in the playoffs, with Edwards leading the charge with three homers and ten RBI, while Gonzalez has scored seven runs.

When Will Ben Come Around?

Ben Aklinski is undoubtedly High Point's best player, but the Rockers need him to truly break out in what is his final ALPB playoff run. In the SDCS, he recorded five hits, three of them doubles, but just one RBI. Aklinski, who holds nearly every Rockers franchise record, has just one thing missing from his resume: a title with High Point. Aklinski is just 1-for-11 in the LCS, but has walked and scored three times. Aklinski is chasing his second ALPB title in five seasons in the league.

It May Come Down To Who's On The Mound

In the SDCS, High Point starters tossed 25.2 innings, allowing 20 hits, 10 runs, nine earned, walked four and struck out 22 for a 3.16 ERA. The bullpen tossed 18.1 innings, allowing 13 hits, eight runs, seven earned, walked six and struck out 17 for a 3.44 ERA. York's bullpen, which didn't allow a run past the fifth inning in the NDCS against Lancaster, surrendered seven runs on 11 hits in Sunday's game over 5.2 IP.

Good Bats Come In Threes

The Rockers have relied on the trio of Luis Gonzalez, Drew Mendoza and Ben Aklinski to drive the offense this season, and the playoffs are no different. Gonzalez ended the season on a 32-game on-base streak, and stretched it to 37 through the first round of the playoffs. Meanwhile, Aklinski and Mendoza each drove in 96 runs, tied for the team lead. Those three combined for 40% of the Rockers run production this season. In the postseason, they've combined to hit .285 (28-for-98) with eight RBI.

Just How He Drew It Up

High Point's Drew Mendoza has come alive in the postseason, becoming a driving force for the offense. In total, Mendoza is hitting .333 (11-for-33) with a pair of doubles, four RBI and five runs scored. His SDCS included a four hit Game Two, followed by a three-hit game Game Five. With the Rockers now in the LCS, Mendoza has an opportunity to capture a ring against his former club in York.

Back To The Wall

The Rockers are looking to join just four other teams in ALPB history to win an LCS after trailing 1-0. Game 1 winners have gone on to win 22 of 26 LCS, including eight in a row.
